Dear Mr. Foamouhoue,

I am pleased to invite you to the first part of the 18th ordinary session of the African Ministerial Conference on the Environment (AMCEN) to be held virtually from 13 to 16 September 2021. The expert segment will take place on 13 and 14 September and the Ministerial segment on 16 September. The meetings will commence at 12:00 East Africa time (10:00 Central Africa time; 09:00 GMT).

In view of the prevailing situation caused by the Covid-19 pandemic and based on consultations with the AMCEN Bureau, it was agreed that the 18th ordinary session of AMCEN should take place in a two-step approach. The first part of the 18th session will take place in a virtual setting to address urgent and procedural matters. Substantive matters that require in-depth negotiations will be deferred to a resumed in-person meeting to be held in 2022.

The 18th session of AMCEN will be held under the theme: 'Securing people's well-being and environmental sustainability in Africa'. A central dimension of building back better is the need for a people-centred recovery that focuses on people's well-being through environmental actions that create jobs and improve livelihoods. Hence, the 18th session of AMCEN will be an opportunity for Ministers to provide strategic guidance towards the implementation of the African Green Stimulus Programme that was adopted by AMCEN to support the continent's recovery after the devastating impacts of Covid-19.

In addition, the session will be an opportunity for Ministers to provide policy guidance and help to strategise on how the region can effectively participate, in a coherent way, in the upcoming key global environmental events, including the 15th session of the Conference of Parties to the United Nations Convention on Biological Diversity (UNCBD COP15), the 26th session of the Conference of Parties to the United Nations Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC COP26) and the resumed session of the 5th United Nations Environment Assembly (UNEA-5.2).
